**DESIGNATION OF UNITED STATES ARMY CYBER COMMAND
AS AN ARMY SERVICE COMPONENT COMMAND**

1. Effectively immediately, the United States Army Cyber Command (UIC: W6UXAA) is designated as an Army service component command to the United States Strategic Command, reporting directly to Headquarters, Department of the Army.
2. United States Army Cyber Command was previously designated as an Army Force Component Headquarters. This General Orders amends Department of the Army General Orders 2014-02 by deleting paragraph 2a and replacing it with the language in paragraph 1, above. The remainder of Department of the Army General Orders 2014-02 remains in effect.
