ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ARMY UNIVERSITY

1. This general order confirms the establishment of the Army University as a subordinate element of the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command (USATRADO) (UIC: W3YTAA) on 29 June 2015.
2. The Army University aligns all the Army's professional military and civilian education programs under a unified academic construct with the goal of increasing academic rigor and relevance; improving integration among Army schools; increasing Soldier, Army Civilian, and leader competence, character, and commitment; enhancing the educational prestige of Army learning institutions; promulgating best management practices; and increasing institutional agility in addressing the needs of the Operating Force.
3. The United States Military Academy (UIC: W1FBAA) is not aligned under the Army University and remains a direct reporting unit (DRU) of the Chief of Staff, Army (CSA) pursuant to General Orders No. 2006-16.
4. The United States War Army College (USAWC) (UIC: W2H6AA) is aligned under the Army University, but remains a DRU of the CSA pursuant to General Orders No. 2013-90 and is separately accredited and governed.
5. The Commander, USATRADO is dual-hatted as the Army University's Chancellor and has integration coordination authority across the Army in matters pertaining to the University.
6. The Commander, U.S. Army Combined Arms Center is dual-hatted as the Army University's Executive Vice Chancellor for Training and Education; the Commandant, USAWC is dual-hatted as the Army University's Vice Chancellor for Strategic Education; and the Deputy Commandant, United States Army Command and General Staff College is dual-hatted the Army University's Provost.
