SUBJECT: Army Directive 2016-29 (Convening Authority for All U.S. Army Reserve Colonel and Lieutenant Colonel Command Boards (Army Promotion List and Army Medical Department))

1. References:

a. Army Regulation 140-10 (Assignments, Attachments, Details and Transfers), 15 August 2005.

b. Memorandum, Assistant Secretary (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), 18 Aug 2010, subject: Request to Change Convening Authority for Army Reserve Lieutenant Colonels Command Assignment Selection Boards.

2. Effective immediately, I rescind reference 1b, which authorizes centrally convening lieutenant colonel Command Assignment Selection Boards.

3. Concurrent with this action, this directive implements authority for the Chief, Army Reserve to centrally convene all Army Reserve colonel and lieutenant colonel Command Assignment Selection Boards (Army Promotion List and Army Medical Department). Board composition and processing will be developed by the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1 and approved by the Chief, Army Reserve.

4. This authority may not be further delegated.

5. The Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1 is the proponent for Army Regulation 140-10 and will incorporate the guidance in this directive into the next revision of the regulation. This directive is rescinded upon publication of the revised regulation.
