**I. GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—By direction of the President, the commanding officer, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, is empowered, pursuant to the eighth article of war, to appoint general courts martial, *effective as of 27 April 1948.*

**II. CASAD SUB-DEPOT OF ROSSFORD ORDNANCE DEPOT, NEW HAVEN, INDIANA.**—1. *Effective as of 28 November 1947,* the Casad Sub-Depot of Rossford Ordnance Depot, New Haven, Indiana, a class II installation under the control of the Chief of Ordnance, was transferred to the control of the Chief of Engineers and placed in an inactive status.

2. *Effective as of 15 April 1948,* the Casad Sub-Depot of Rossford Ordnance Depot, New Haven, Indiana, was redesignated the Casad Engineer Depot, a class II installation under the control of the Chief of Engineers, and will remain in an inactive status.

**III. ROTC UNIT.**—1. *Effective 1 July 1948,* a Medical Corps ROTC unit will be established at the University of Kansas School of Medicine, Kansas City, Kansas.
