I. GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.—By direction of the President the commanding officer, Ryukyus Command, is empowered, pursuant to the eighth article of war, to appoint general courts martial, *effective as of 20 August 1948.*

II. ROTC UNITS.—1. *Effective as of 1 August 1948*, a Medical Corps ROTC unit was established at Emory University, Emory University, Georgia.

2. The Oak Ridge Military Institute, Oak Ridge, North Carolina, a Class MI ROTC school is converted to and redesignated a Class JCMI ROTC school.

3. Paragraph 1, section II, General Orders 53, Department of the Army, 1948, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

III. BINGHAMTON MEDICAL DEPOT, BINGHAMTON, N. Y.—*Effective as of 14 August 1948*, Binghamton Medical Depot, Binghamton, New York, was transferred from the jurisdiction of the Department of the Army to the Department of the Air Force.

IV. CAMP MACKALL, NORTH CAROLINA.—*Effective as of 29 June 1946*, Camp Mackall, North Carolina, was designated a subinstallation of Fort Bragg, North Carolina, a Class I installation under the control of the Commanding General, Third Army.

V. WARRIOR OF PACIFIC RIFLE COMPETITION.—1. In accordance with the provisions of Memorandum 850-110-1 the annual Warrior of the Pacific rifle competition was conducted at Infantry ROTC summer camps. It has been determined that the team representing the University of Puerto Rico has won the Warrior of the Pacific Competition for the year 1948.

2. The Department of the Army announces that the bronze statuette, "The Warrior of the Pacific," now in the possession of West Virginia University, is awarded to the University of Puerto Rico to be retained until such time as the award for the 1949 competition may be published.

3. The winning teams, in order of merit, are as follows:
