**I..ARMY AND NAVY HOSPITAL, HOT SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.**—Effective 28 February 1954, the Army and Naval Hospital, Hot Springs, Arkansas, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is placed in an inactive status.

**II..CAMP SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA.**—1. Effective 15 November 1953, Camp San Luis Obispo, California, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, is redesignated a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army, and placed in an inactive status.

2. Section V, DA General Orders 56, 1953, is rescinded.
