I..HEADQUARTERS, TRANSPORTATION SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE COMMAND.—Effective 1 March 1955, Headquarters, Transportation Supply and Maintenance Command is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, at St. Louis, Missouri, and will consist of the following:

1. Transportation Materiel Command, Marietta, Pennsylvania, and its subordinate activities.
2. Transportation Corps Army Aviation Field Service Office, St. Louis, Missouri, and its subordinate activities.

II..ARMY AVIATION CENTER.—Effective 1 February 1955, the Army Aviation Center is established as a class I activity, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army, at Camp Rucker, Alabama, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army. The Army Aviation Center will consist of the Army Aviation School and such other activities as may be assigned.

III..ALAMEDA MEDICAL DEPOT.—Effective 30 June 1955, the Alameda Medical Depot, California, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is discontinued.

IV..OAKLAND QUARTERMASTER MARKET CENTER.—Effective 1 May 1955, the Oakland Quartermaster Market Center, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General, located at 124 Grand Avenue, Oakland, California, is relocated to 2155 Webster Street, Alameda, California.
