I..SUNNY POINT ARMY TERMINAL, NORTH CAROLINA. *Effective 1 November 1955*, the Sunny Point Army Terminal, North Carolina, a class III installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, is placed in an active status.

II..THEODORE ARMY TERMINAL, ALABAMA. *Effective 30 November 1955*, the Theodore Army Terminal, Alabama, a class III installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, is placed in an inactive status.

III..CAMP RUCKER, ALABAMA. *Effective 13 October 1955*, Camp Rucker, Alabama, is redesignated Fort Rucker, Alabama, and announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.

IV..CIVIL AFFAIRS AND MILITARY GOVERNMENT SCHOOL, CAMP GORDON, GEORGIA. *Effective 17 October 1955*, the Civil Affairs and Military Government School is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Civil Affairs and Military Government, at the Provost Marshal General Center, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Provost Marshal General, located at Camp Gordon, Georgia.

V..CAMP POLK, LOUISIANA. 1. *Effective 1 November 1955*, Camp Polk, Louisiana, is redesignated Fort Polk and announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.

2. *Effective 1 November 1955*, Fort Polk, Louisiana, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fourth Army, is placed in an active status.
