I. U. S. ARMY MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DEVELOPMENT LABORATORY, FORT TOTTEN, NEW YORK. Effective 1 January 1957, the U. S. Army Medical Equipment Development Laboratory is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, with location at Fort Totten, New York.

II. ARMY MEDICAL OPTICAL ACTIVITY, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI. Effective 1 January 1957, the Army Medical Optical Activity, St. Louis, Missouri, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is redesignated the U. S. Army Medical Optical and Maintenance Activity.

III. 9926 TECHNICAL SERVICE UNIT, ARMY COMPLEMENT, ARMED SERVICES MEDICAL PROCUREMENT AGENCY. Effective 1 January 1957, the 9926 Technical Service Unit, Army Complement, Armed Services Medical Procurement Agency, Brooklyn, New York, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is discontinued.
