I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, United States Continental Army Command, Fort Monroe, Virginia, is designated by the Secretary of the Army pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22 (a) (U), to convene general courts-martial, effective 27 January 1958.

II. SCHUYLKILL ARSENAL, PENNSYLVANIA. Effective 1 April 1958, Schuylkill Arsenal, Pennsylvania, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second United States Army, is placed in an inactive status.

III. CURTIS BAY STORAGE ACTIVITY, MARYLAND. Effective 28 December 1957, the Curtis Bay Storage Activity, Maryland, a class II storage activity of Letterkenny Ordnance Depot, under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is placed in an inactive status.

IV. TARHEEL ORDNANCE PLANT, NORTH CAROLINA. Effective 1 January 1958, the Government-owned facility formerly known as the Firestone Tire and Rubber Plant (also known as Fairchild Engine and Airplane Corporation), Burlington, North Carolina, is designated the Tarheel Ordnance Plant, North Carolina, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

V. U. S. ARMY ELEMENT, U. S. ARMY-AIR FORCE EXCHANGE SERVICE (8694). Effective 19 December 1957, the U. S. Army Element, U. S. Army-Air Force Exchange Service (8694), a class II field activity of the Department of the Army Administrative Area, is discontinued; concurrent with discontinuance of unit, the U. S. Army Element, U. S. Army-Air Force Exchange Service (9120) is established effective 20 December 1957 as a class II field activity under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General.
