I. THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT POLK, LOUISIANA. Effective 25 August 1961, the United States Army Training Center, Fort Polk, Louisiana, is established as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fourth United States Army.

II. THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT GORDON, GEORGIA. Effective 31 August 1961, the United States Army Training Center, Fort Gordon, Georgia, is established as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third United States Army.

III. INDIANA ARSENAL, INDIANA. Effective 23 August 1961, the Indiana Arsenal, Charleston, Indiana, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is placed in an active status.

IV. NORTH DEPOT ACTIVITY, NEW YORK. Effective 1 January 1962, the North Depot Activity, New York, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, located at the Seneca Ordnance Depot, New York, is combined and consolidated with the Seneca Ordnance Depot, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

V. U.S. ARMY ELEMENT, AIR FORCE MISSILE TEST CENTER. The U.S. Army Element, Air Force Missile Test Center is hereby designated a class II activity under the command of the Chief of Research and Development. Designation, organization, mission and table of distribution number remain unchanged.

VI. DE LA SALLE MILITARY ACADEMY, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI. Effective 1 June 1960, the NDCC unit at De La Salle Military Academy, Kansas City, Missouri, was withdrawn.
