I.—NATIONAL GUARD COMPUTER CENTER. *Effective 1 February 1965*, the National Guard Computer Center is organized as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief, National Guard Bureau, with location at the Nassif Building, Baileys Crossroads, Virginia.

II.—LIVONIA STORAGE FACILITY, MICHIGAN. *Effective 15 June 1964*, the Livonia Storage Facility, Michigan, was discontinued as a Department of the Army facility.

III.—GRAND BLANC STORAGE FACILITY NO. 2, CALIFORNIA. *Effective 19 May 1964*, the Grand Blanc Storage Facility No. 2, California, was discontinued as a Department of the Army facility.

IV.—BEAVER ARMY TERMINAL, OREGON. *Effective 31 December 1964*, the Beaver Army Terminal, Oregon, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is placed in an inactive status.

V.—RIO VISTA STORAGE AREA, CALIFORNIA. *Effective 31 December 1964*, the Rio Vista Storage Area, California, a class II inactive installation, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is placed in an active status and redesignated a class II activity of Sharpe Army Depot, California, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command.
