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I. U.S. ARMY INTELLIGENCE CENTER. *Effective 1 October 1965,* the U.S. Army Intelligence Center, Fort Holabird, Maryland, a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second U.S. Army, is discontinued.

II. THEODORE ARMY TERMINAL, ALABAMA. *Effective 14 June 1965,* the Theodore Army Terminal, Alabama, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
