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**I. UNITED STATES ARMY COURIER SERVICE HEADQUARTERS.** *Effective 15 January 1966*, the United States Army Courier Service Headquarters (AG 4001 00) is organized as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General, with location at Washington, D.C.

**II. UNITED STATES ARMY COURIER TRANSFER STATIONS.**  
*a. Effective 15 January 1966*, the following United States Army Courier Transfer Stations, together with their functions, personnel, records and equipment, are transferred from commands indicated and established as subordinate activities of the United States Army Courier Service Headquarters, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General:

**III. CHICAGO PROCUREMENT DISTRICT, U.S. ARMY.** *Effective 31 December 1965*, the Chicago Procurement District, U.S. Army, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, and located at 623 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, is discontinued.

**IV. NEW YORK PROCUREMENT DISTRICT, U.S. ARMY.** *Effective 31 December 1965*, the New York Procurement District, U.S. Army, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, and located at 770 Broadway, New York, New York, is discontinued.

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V. **FORT SLOCUM, NEW YORK.** *Effective 31 December 1965,* Fort Slocum, New York, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First U.S. Army, is placed in an inactive status.
