2. (U) BACKGROUND.

2.A. (U) MEDICAL COMMUNICATIONS FOR COMBAT CASUALTY CARE (MC4), ALSO KNOWN AS ARMY OPERATIONAL HEALTH INFORMATION SYSTEMS (AOHIS), IS A RUGGEDIZED HARDWARE PACKAGE CONTAINING MEDICAL SOFTWARE FIELDIED TO ARMY OPERATIONAL MEDICAL FORCES WORLDWIDE, PROVIDING THE TOOLS TO DIGITALLY RECORD AND TRANSFER CRITICAL MEDICAL DATA FROM POINT OF INJURY TO MEDICAL TREATMENT FACILITIES WORLDWIDE.

2.B. (U) THE MEDICAL CENTER OF EXCELLENCE, FUTURE FORCE INTEGRATION DIRECTORATE HAS AMENDED THE BASIS OF ISSUE (BOI) TO DOCUMENT THAT ONLY ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD (EHR) REQUIREMENTS WILL REMAIN ON THE MODIFIED TABLE OF EQUIPMENT.

2.C. (U) ARMY DEEP DIVE DECISIONS RESULTED IN FUNDING DECREMENTS FOR AOHIS/MC4 THAT WILL RESULT IN MC4 PROGRAM TERMINATION NO LATER THAN 30 SEPTEMBER 2023.

3. (U) PURPOSE. THIS MESSAGE PROVIDES NOTIFICATION OF MC4 AMENDED BOI AND PROGRAM TERMINATION.

4. (U) EXECUTION.

4.A. (U) PRODUCT MANAGER MEDICAL COMMUNICATIONS FOR COMBAT CASUALTY CARE (PM MC4) WILL CONTINUE TO FIELD OR UPGRADE MC4 SYSTEMS THROUGH 2<sup>ND</sup> QUARTER FISCAL YEAR 2023 (2QFY23). PM MC4 WILL PRIORITIZE REMAINING FIELDINGS TO SUPPORT DEPLOYING MEDICAL UNITS, TO INCLUDE ROLE 3 CAPABILITIES.

4.B. (U) BOI AMENDMENTS WILL TAKE EFFECT IN FY23 PENDING APPROVAL AND DOCUMENTATION BY DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF, G-3/5/7.

4.C. (U) DOCUMENTATION OF BOI AMENDMENTS WILL RESULT IN EXCESS EQUIPMENT IN MANY UNITS. AT THAT TIME, U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND MEDICAL LEAD MATERIEL INTEGRATOR, THROUGH THE DECISION SUPPORT TOOL (DST), WILL INITIATE THE PROCESS TO LATERALLY TRANSFER EXCESS EQUIPMENT TO FILL SHORTAGES. PRODUCT MANAGER MEDICAL COMMUNICATIONS FOR COMBAT CASUALTY CARE.

4.D. (U) UNITS WILL NOT DIVEST MC4 LINE ITEM NUMBERS (LINS) AS A RESULT OF BOI AMENDMENTS. UNITS WILL ONLY DIVEST MC4 SYSTEMS IDENTIFIED ON THE MASTER DIVESTITURE LIST IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.E. OR IF IDENTIFIED TO LATERALLY TRANSFER EQUIPMENT.

4.E. (U) MC4 LINS INCLUDE C18345, C18277, C18209, C27639, C41358, AND C27571.

4.F. (U) UNIT PROVIDED HARDWARE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR NON-EHR FUNCTIONS INCLUDING MEDICAL COMMAND AND CONTROL (C2), PATIENT MOVEMENT, MEDICAL LOGISTICS (MEDLOG), AND MEDICAL SITUATIONAL AWARENESS AS IDENTIFIED IN REFERENCE 1.F.

4.G. (U) UNITS MAY PROCURE COMMERCIAL OFF THE SHELF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.A. TO MEET NON-EHR OPERATIONAL HEALTH INFORMATION SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS.

4.H. (U) MC4 PROGRAM OFFICE IN-PERSON TRAINING AND FIELD SUPPORT WILL BE PHASED OUT NO LATER THAN 2QFY23.

4.I. (U) MC4 PROGRAM OFFICE WILL MAINTAIN THE AUTHORITY TO OPERATE AND THE AUTHORITY TO CONNECT FOR FIELDED SYSTEMS THROUGH PROGRAM TERMINATION (FY23).

4.J. (U) SOFTWARE FOR EHR. FOR UNITS TO KEEP CURRENT WITH THE EHR SOFTWARE UNTIL 30 SEPTEMBER 2023, CONTACT AN MC4 REPRESENTATIVE AT [HTTPS://WWW.MC4.ARMY.MIL/CONTACTS/MC4CONTACTS.ASPX](https://www.mc4.army.mil/contacts/mc4contacts.aspx).

4.K. (U) THEATER MEDICAL INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS WILL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP BEYOND FY23.

5.A. (U) PATIENT MOVEMENT. TRANSCOM REGULATING AND COMMAND AND CONTROL EVACUATION SYSTEM (TRAC2ES) IS AVAILABLE THROUGH [HTTPS://TRAC2ES.TRANSPORT.MIL/](https://trac2es.transport.mil/).

5.B. (U) MEDICAL C2 AND SITUATIONAL AWARENESS. MEDICAL COMMON OPERATING PICTURE (MEDCOP) IS A UNIVERSALLY ACCESSIBLE MISSION COMMAND PLATFORM THAT PROVIDES REAL-TIME CRITICAL ASSETS AND RESOURCES AT THE STRATEGIC, OPERATIONAL, AND TACTICAL LEVELS TO SUPPORT THE MEDICAL COMMUNITY OF INTEREST.
