
1. Effective 1 October 1991, the functions of the Directorate of Clothing and Services are WITHDRAWN from the U.S. Army Troop Support Agency (UIC: W3P8AA) and are assigned to the U.S. Army Materiel Command (UIC: W05XAA).
2. Effective 1 October 1991, the functions supporting the Army Food Program relating to construction, modernization, and equipment replacement for dining facilities and troop issue activities and the agency requirement to provide the Army member for the Joint Technical Staff, Department of Defense Food RDTE Program at U.S. Army Natick Research and Development Laboratories are WITHDRAWN from the U.S. Army Troop Support Agency (UIC: W3P8AA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Quartermaster Center and School, Army Center of Excellence, Subsistence, (UIC: W1D5AA).
3. Effective 30 September 1991, the U.S. Army Troop Support Agency (UIC: W3P8AA, W4XBAA, W4BDAA, W4H4AA, W4XAAA, W4W9AA, W373AA, W360AA, W36YAA, W36XAA, W4LHAA, and W36ZAA) is DISESTABLISHED as a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics. The commissary mission, functions, personnel and all remaining assets of U.S. Army Troop Support Agency are transferred to the Defense Commissary Agency.
