SUBJECT: Army Directive 2018-25 (Change of Program Objective Memorandum Program Evaluation Group Co-Chairs)

1. References:

a. Army Regulation 1-1 (Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution), 23 May 2016.

b. Memorandum, Under Secretary of the Army and Vice Chief of Staff of the Army, 14 Feb 2018, subject: Implementation of Deputy Under Secretary Recommendations.

2. Effective immediately, there will be five Program Evaluation Groups (PEGs). Each PEG will be co-chaired as specified in this revised table 2-1 in AR 1-1:

PEG	Secretariat Co-chair	Command Co-chair	Management and Day-to-Day Operations
Manning	ASA (M&RA)	Commander, TRADOC	DCS, G-1
Training	ASA (M&RA)	Commander, FORSCOM	DCS, G-3/5/7
Sustainment	ASA (ALT)	Commander, AMC	DCS, G-4
Equipping	ASA (ALT)	Commander, AFC	DCS, G-8
Installations	ASA (IE&E)	Commander, AMC & IMCOM	ACSIM

3. PEGs receive executive and administrative support from the Army Staff principal listed in the right column of table 2-1.


4. Effective immediately, the following responsibilities assigned in Army Regulation 1-1 are revised:

a. The role and responsibilities of the PEG co-chairs cannot be delegated. The Assistant Secretary and the Commander must serve as co-chairs.

b. The Installations Command co-chair is a shared responsibility between the Commander, U.S. Army Materiel Command and the Commander, U.S. Army Installation Management Command.

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- c. The co-chairs are the decision authority within the PEG.
- 5. This directive applies to the Regular Army, Army National Guard/Army National Guard of the United States, and U.S. Army Reserve.
- 6. The Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management and Comptroller) is the proponent for this directive and will ensure its provisions are incorporated into Army Regulation 1-1 as soon as possible, but no later than 2 years from the date of this directive.
- 7. This directive is rescinded upon publication of the revised regulation.
