

**REASSIGNMENT OF U.S. ARMY INSTALLATION MANAGEMENT COMMAND AS A
MAJOR SUBORDINATE COMMAND OF U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND**

1. Effective 1 March 2019, U.S. Army Installation Management Command (IMCOM) (UIC: W6BDAA), together with its subordinate element (U.S. Army Environmental Command (UIC: W3V8AA)), authorities, responsibilities, personnel, and resources (including funding and equipment) is discontinued as a direct reporting unit to the Chief of Staff, Army (UIC: W0ZUAA) and is reassigned as a major subordinate command of U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC) (UIC: W0GWAA).
2. The Commanding General (CG), AMC will exercise all authority, direction, command and control over IMCOM, to include prescribing IMCOM missions, functions, and responsibilities. All personnel, equipment, and other resources (for example, contracts and budgeted funds) assigned or allocated to IMCOM and its components are transferred and reassigned under the authority, direction, command and control of the CG, AMC.
3. Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 2015-05, dated 23 October 2015, is hereby superseded.
