



**REASSIGNMENT AND REDESIGNATION OF U.S. ARMY MEDICAL RESEARCH AND MATERIEL  
COMMAND AND ESTABLISHMENT OF THE U.S. ARMY MEDICAL LOGISTICS COMMAND**

1. Effective 1 October 2018, U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command (unit identification code (UIC): W03JAA) was reassigned from U.S. Army Medical Command (UIC: W3VYAA) to U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC) (UIC: W0GWAA). This reassignment included the transfer of authorities, responsibilities, personnel, and resources, except for administrative control authority for funding and manpower, which U.S. Army Medical Command retained until 30 September 2019.
2. Effective 1 June 2019, U.S. Army Medical Logistics Command (UIC: W0FEAA) was established as a subordinate command to AMC. Additionally, on 1 June 2019, U.S. Army Medical Materiel Agency (UIC: W05JAA); U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center, Europe (UIC: W0CCAA); and U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center, Korea (UIC: W6R1AA) were reassigned from Medical Research and Materiel Command to Medical Logistics Command. This reassignment included the transfer of authorities, responsibilities, personnel, and resources (funding, equipment, and property).
3. Effective 1 June 2019, Medical Research and Materiel Command was redesignated U.S. Army Medical Research and Development Command (UIC: W03JAA). Medical Research and Development Command and its authorities; responsibilities; designated subordinate elements (except for Medical Materiel Agency; Medical Materiel Center, Europe; and Medical Materiel Center, Korea); personnel; and resources (including funding and equipment) were reassigned from AMC to U.S. Army Futures Command (UIC: W0CUAA).
4. The Commanding General, Medical Research and Development Command is designated as a General Courts-Martial Convening Authority pursuant to Article 22(a)(8), Uniform Code of Military Justice, effective 1 June 2019.
5. The provisions of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 2006-35, dated 16 October 2006; No. 1994-20, dated 10 August 1994; and No. 1993-21, dated 30 September 1993 inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
