



**REASSIGNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY CONTINUING EDUCATION DIVISION
(ACED) FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMY HUMAN RESOURCES COMMAND TO THE
UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING AND DOCTRINE COMMAND**

1. Effective 1 October 2019, the United States Army Continuing Education Division (ACED) (UIC: W6ED24), a subordinate element of United States Army Human Resources Command, is reassigned as a subordinate element of United States Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) (UIC: W3YTAA) PARA 072, 072B, and 072C.
2. The Commanding General, TRADOC will exercise all authority, direction, and control over the ACED, to include prescribing ACED missions, functions, and responsibilities. The Chief, ACED will report to the Army University Provost, under the authority of the Commanding General, TRADOC. All personnel, equipment, and other resources assigned or allocated to the ACED and its components are transferred and reassigned under the authority, direction, and control of the Commanding General, TRADOC.
