**DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY TEST AND EVALUATION
COMMAND AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT**


1. Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Test and Evaluation Command (ATEC) (UIC: W3Q2AA) is designated as a direct reporting unit of the Chief of Staff, Army.
2. ATEC plans, integrates, and conducts experiments, developmental testing, independent operational testing, and independent evaluations and assessments to provide essential information to acquisition decisionmakers and commanders.
3. Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section I of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 1999-12, dated 31 December 1999, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
