UNITED STATES ARMY CENTER OF MILITARY HISTORY

- 1. Effective 14 March 2007, the United States Army Center of Military History (CMH) (UIC: W3YUAA), a Field Operating Agency under the oversight of the Director of the Army Staff, is transferred to the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army. This transfer includes missions, personnel, equipment, funding, and resources.
- 2. The mission of the United States Army Center of Military History is to: formulate and execute the Army Historical Program; supervise and coordinate the Army Museum System, to include all Army art and artifact collections; prepare and publish the official history of the United States Army and associated historical products needed by the service; formulate the historical background and precedent required for the development of military plans, policies, doctrine, and techniques; collect and maintain repositories for the preservation of historical documents, art, and artifacts relating to the United States Army; maintain the honors and lineage, and historical designation systems that apply to all Army units and organizations; and coordinate with and assist public and private agencies and individuals in all matters regarding Army history.
