



**REDESIGNATION OF THE OPERATIONAL SUPPORT AIRLIFT ACTIVITY AND
ITS SUBORDINATE COMMAND**

1. This is to confirm that effective 4 October 2015, the Operational Support Airlift Agency (OSAA) unit identification code (UIC: W36VAA) (a field operating agency of the Director, Army National Guard, Davison Army Airfield, Fort Belvoir, Virginia) and its subordinate command, Operational Support Airlift Command (OSACOM) (UIC: W3G2AA) were assigned to the United States Army Air Operations Group (USAAOG) (UIC: W6GYAA) (a subordinate command of Headquarters, U.S. Army Military District of Washington (MDW)), and OSAA was redesignated the Operational Support Airlift Activity (OSA-A).
2. This is to confirm that effective 4 October 2015, in addition to the organizations listed in Department of the Army General Orders 2006-8, paragraph 1, the USAAOG will provide integrated command, control, and coordination of the OSA-A and its subordinate command, OSACOM.
3. The Commanding General, U.S. Army MDW, will exercise general courts-martial jurisdiction over all personnel assigned or attached to U.S. Army MDW, to include OSA-A and OSACOM personnel. The Commander, U.S. Army MDW USAAOG, will exercise summary and special courts-martial jurisdiction over all personnel assigned or attached to the U.S. Army MDW USAAOG, to include OSA-A and OSACOM personnel. The Commander, OSA-A will exercise summary courts-martial jurisdiction over all personnel assigned or attached to OSA-A or OSACOM.
4. Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders Number 11, dated 1 August 1995, is hereby superseded. Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders Number 8, dated 17 July 2006 remains in effect, except as modified by this General Orders.
